The proposed West Four Quiet Zone will impose a 24- hour restriction on the routine sounding of locomotive horns within the West Four Quiet Zone. The West Four Quiet Zone is created pursuant to 49 CFR 222.39.

The City's plan for implementing improvements within the proposed West Four Quiet Zone is to add constant warning time devises at the West Ohio Avenue crossing and to utilize pre-existing Supplemental Safety Measures (SSMs) at the Richmond Parkway crossing. In addition, the City will work on improvements acceptable to the California Public Utilities Commission, Federal Railroad Administration and the railroad impacted by the creation of the West Four Quiet Zone. The City will continually consult with all involved entities concerning appropriate improvements.
